- **Armando Parusso 2015 Barolo Bussia – 95 POINTS**
- The 2015 Barolo Bussia is fabulous. Rich and dramatic in scale, the 2015 is a total stunner. Dark cherry, plum, chocolate, spice, coffee and leather develop in a Barolo endowed with tremendous vertical lift and pure power. The 2015 is silky, heady and beautifully textured from start to finish. There is so much to admire.

- **Armando Parusso 2015 Barolo Mosconi - 94 POINTS**
- The 2015 Barolo Mosconi is a dark, potent wine. Black cherry, chocolate, leather, smokeblood orange and licorice add to the wine's virile personality. A big, ample Barolo, the 2015 shows all the natural richness of this Monforte site, where the wines tend to be quite broad in feel. Readers should be prepared to give the 2015 at least a few years in bottle.

- **Armando Parusso 2015 Barolo Mariondino – 93 POINTS**
- The 2015 Barolo Mariondino is richer, deeper and more powerful than it usually is, with an extra kick of volume and sheer breadth. The floral notes that are typical of this cool site on sandy soils emerge over time, but the 2015 remains a big wine. Dark fruit, licorice, chocolate and spice add to the wine's potent feel. Readers should expect an unusually large-scaled Mariondino.

- Parusso's 2015 Barolo is gorgeous. Dark, ample and enveloping, the 2015 possesses tremendous textural richness and depth. Even so, the 2015 is wonderfully open-knit and nuanced. Silky tannins and plush fruit adds to the wine's considerable appeal. This is a gorgeous wine, not to mention a huge overachiever in its peer group.
